Building of DMW, Patiala with all original and self attested copies of Certificates alongwith two passport size photographs. Suitability shall be adjudged by Selection Committee.

## <u>TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR ENTERING INTO CONTRACT</u> <u>WITH MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS :-</u>

- 1. The selected candidates are required to enter into the contract. Period of contract is upto 31.03.2022 or till the pandemic continues, whichever is earlier.
- 2. The Contract Medical Practitioner/ General Duty Medical Officer (hereinafter referred to as CMP/GDMO) who enters into contract with Railways will not have any claim or right for his/her continuity in service or automatic extension of the term of contract.
- 3. During the validity of the contract, the CMP/GDMO will be at liberty to terminate the contract for betterment of his/her career or on any other grounds by giving 07 days notice to Railways. The contract can also be terminated by the Railways at any time during the contract by giving 07 days notice without assigning any reason whatsoever. Contract shall also be terminated if the CMP/GDMO is found to be mentally or physically incapacitated. However if CMP/GDMO leaves without notice or before completion of 07 days notice, he/she shall be liable to pay the amount for the required period as per prevailing rates.
- 4. At the time of entering into contract, the CMP/GDMO shall produce original certificates for proof of his /her date of birth and educational qualifications and Character Certificate from Gazetted officer.
- 5. The CMP/GDMO shall undergo a medical examination, before the contract is entered into, for his/ her fitness to perform the work awarded to him/her.
- 6. Normally Sundays and National Holidays will be off and in addition, authorized absence without detriment to the terms shall be allowed at the rate of two days per month to be availed any time during the contract to the extent earned by the CMP/GDMO till such time. Any CMP/GDMO leaving his place of work on leave or absence/National Holidays should get prior permission of the controlling authority.
- 7. Expenses on outstation journeys connected with the contracted works will be borne by the Railway. Duty passes will be issued by the Railways for the purpose of journey and the CMP/GDMO will be paid a fixed rate of Daily allowance, i.e. ₹400/- only (Rupees Four Hundred Only) per day during such journey. This will be subject to fulfillment of other provisions pertaining to Daily Allowance prescribed in IREC Vol.II.
- **8.** The daily proportionate deduction from the fee in the event the CMP absents himself/herself are at the following rates:-

- 09 CMP/GDMO may be provided un-furnished accommodation subject to availability. In case Railway accommodation is provided to the CMP/GDMO, an amount equivalent to the sum of HRA and license fee of the accommodation so provided shall be deducted from the monthly fee admissible to the CMP/GDMO.
- 10. The CMP/GDMO may avail of free medical treatment for self only
- 11. The CMP/GDMO shall be governed in respect of matters not referred to in these terms and conditions by any orders/ amendments to the terms of contract issued by the Railways from time to time. In case specific instructions are not issued for

CMP/GDMO, the conditions of service as applicable to ADMO shall be applicable in this case also.

- 12. The CMP/GDMO shall also not be entitled to any benefit like Provident Fund, Pension, Gratuity, Non-Practicing Allowance, Seniority, Promotion, etc. or any other benefits available to the Railway servants appointed on regular basis.
- 13 The CMP/GDMO shall attend to all normal tasks which any medical practitioner is conventionally doing. He/she will also attend to emergencies and accidents.
- 14. The CMP/GDMO shall not make medical recommendation of any kind referred to para 559 to 564 of Indian Railway Medical Manual (IRMM), 2000.
- 15. The CMP/GDMO will not have any financial powers.
- 16 The CMP/GDMO shall not initiate/review/ accept the APARs of Group 'C' Railway employees.
- 17. The CMP/GDMO shall not indent or condemn/recommend for condemnation of any tools & plants.

## <u>Terms & conditions of the contract of Retired Railway Doctors to be engaged as</u> <u>Contract Medical Practitioners</u>

- 1. The selected candidates are required to enter into the contract. Period of contract is upto 31.03.2022 or till the pandemic continues, whichever is earlier.
- 2. Retired Railway Doctor should not more than 65 years of age at the time of engagement.
- 3. The engagement shall purely be on contract basis..
- 4. The retired Railway Doctor engaged as Contract Medical Practitioner shall not have any claim or right for his/her continuity in service or automatic extension of the term of contract.
- 5. During the validity of the contract, the CMP shall be at liberty to terminate the contract for betterment of his / her career or on any other ground by giving 07 days notice to the Railways. The contract can also be terminated by the Railways at any time during the contract by giving 07 days notice without assigning any reasons whatsoever. Contract shall also be terminated, if the CMP is found to be mentally or physically incapacitated. However if CMP leaves without notice or before completion of 07 days notice, he/she shall be liable to pay the amount for the required period as per prevailing rates.
- 6. The CMP shall undergo a medical examination, before the contract is entered into, for his/ her fitness to perform the work awarded to him/her.
- 7. At the time of entering into contract, the CMP shall produce original certificates for proof of his /her date of birth and educational qualifications.
- 8. Normally Sundays and National Holidays shall be off and in addition, authorized absence without detriment to the terms shall be allowed at the rate of two days per month to be availed any time during the contract to the extent earned by the CMP till such time. Any CMP leaving his / her place of work on leave or absence/national holidays should obtain prior permission of the controlling authority.
- 9. Expenses on outstation journeys connected with the contracted works shall be borne by the Railway. Duty passes shall be issued by the Railways for the purpose of journey in the line of jurisdiction of the Health Unit where the CMP renders service and to the Divisional Headquarters and the CMP shall be paid a fixed rate of Daily allowance, i.e. ₹.400/- only (Rupees Four Hundred Only) per day during such journey. This will be subject to fulfillment of other provisions pertaining to Daily Allowance prescribed in Indian Railway Establishment Code, Vol.-II.
- 10. In the event of unauthorized absence of Contract Medical Practitioner from duty or absence from duty for a period exceeding the period stipulated in the contract, there shall be proportionate deduction from remuneration.
- 11. The retired Railway/Govt. Doctors engaged as CMPs may be provided with Railway accommodation at places where ear-marked. Railway accommodation for Railway doctors is vacant / available after meeting the residential requirement of the serving Railway officers. In case Railway accommodation is provided to the Contract Medical Practitioner, an amount equivalent to HRA payable to a fresh entrant to Group 'A' Jr. Scale and license fee of the Railway accommodation so provided shall be deducted from the monthly remuneration payable to the Contract Medical Practitioner.
- 12. No Railway Privilege Passes/PTOs shall be admissible to retired Railway doctors engaged as CMPs in his/her capacity of Contract Medical Practitioner.
- 13. The CMP shall be governed in respect of matters not referred to in these terms and conditions by any orders/ amendments to the terms of the contract issued by the Ministry of Railways from time to time. In case specific instructions are not issued for CMP, the conditions of service as applicable to ADMO shall be applicable in this case also.

- 14. The CMP shall attend to all normal tasks which any medical practitioner is conventionally doing. He/she will also attend to emergencies and accidents.
- 15. No Financial or Administrative powers shall be vested in retired Railway/ Govt. Doctors engaged as CMPs.
- 16. The CMP shall also not be entitled to any benefit like Provident Fund, Pension, Gratuity, Non-Practicing Allowance, Medical facilities, Seniority, Promotion, etc. or any other benefits available to the Railway servants appointed on regular basis.
- 17. In case of retired Railway/ Govt. Doctor engaged as CMP, remuneration shall be subject to the condition that Remuneration + Pension shall not exceed the last pay drawn. No Dearness Allowance and any other Allowances which are admissible to regular Railway servants shall be admissible.
- 18. The retired Railway/Govt.Doctor engaged as CMP shall be on full time appointment of the Railways and shall not accept any other appointment, paid or otherwise and shall not engage himself/herself in a private practice of any kind during the period of contract.
- 19. The CMP shall not perform administrative work like pre-employment or periodical medical examinations, sanction of leave to Group 'C' and 'D' staff and certificate with respect to food items considered unfit for human consumption, etc. However, the CMP, wherever he/she is the only doctor available, shall be allowed to permit Group 'C' and 'D' staff casual leave if sought for 3 days or less at a stretch.
- 20. The CMP shall not make medical recommendation of any kind referred to in Paras 559 to 564 of Indian Railway Medical Manual (IRMM), 2000.
- 21. The CMP will not have any financial powers. However, he/she may operate the imprest account in accordance with the guidelines contained in the IRMM. However, the cash vouchers in such cases shall be got countersigned by an authorized Railway Medical Officer. No cash imprest account shall be recouped unless the proposal is countersigned by an Indian Railway Medical Service Officer.
- 22. The CMP shall not initiate/review/ accept the Annual Confidential Reports of Group 'C' Railway employees. However, he/she shall, on request, prepare and present the performance report of the staff.
- 23. The CMP shall not indent or condemn/recommend for condemnation any tools and plants.

# <u>TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR THE ENGAGEMENT OF PARA-MEDICAL</u> <u>STAFF (NURSES) ON CONTRACT BASIS</u>

- 1. The candidates will have to make their own arrangements for their stay in Patiala.
- 2. Working candidates are required to declare their present employment before they appear in the interview .
- 3. Duty hours for the engaged candidates shall be the same as for the concerned post. The posting of the staff shall be as per the requirement of the Medical Deptt. DMW Patiala.
- 4. The candidates shall be engaged for a period upto 31.03.2022 or till the pandemic continues, whichever is earlier.
- 5. The contractual candidates will be permitted off on Sunday and National Holidays. However, they can be called for duty on any day including Sundays & National Holidays. Contractual candidate may be granted two days leave per month.
- 6. Dismissed/Removed/Compulsory/Voluntarily Retired Employees who have been punished under Disciplinary rules in last 05 years of Service are not eligible.
- 7. Retired employee should not have been covered under the safety related retirement Scheme/ Liberalized Active Retirement Scheme for Guaranteed Employment for Safety Staff (LARSGESS).
- 8. For engaged candidates, Medical fitness shall be obtained from the DMW Hospital before joining.
- 9. At the time of entering into contract, candidates shall produce original certificates for proof of his/her date of birth and education qualification and Character Certificate from Gazetted officer.
- 10. During the validity of the contract, the engaged candidate will be at liberty to terminate the contract for betterment of his/her career or on any other grounds by giving one week notice to Railways. The contract can also be terminated by the Railways at any time during the contract by giving one week notice without assigning any reason whatsoever. Contract shall also be terminated if the engaged candidate is found to be mentally or physically incapacitated. However if engaged candidate leaves without notice or before completion of one week notice, he/she shall be liable to pay the amount for the required period as per prevailing rates.
